You are hereby advised that the recommended acceptable range for corrosivity as established by the State of New Jersey is: within +or- 1.0 of the optimum pH as determined by the Langlier Index.

The laboratory analysis revealed that the water supply serving the subject property did _____ did not _____ meet the recommended State limits.

If your sample did not meet the recommended limits please be advised that corrosive water can lead to the deterioration of metal pipes and water related appliances. The water may also liberate toxic metals, such as lead and copper, from the water system.

To protect the water supply system from damage and to prevent the ingestion of metals, we recommend that a neutralizer be installed and properly maintained. Meanwhile, we suggest that you run the water each morning, before use, long enough to flush out the water that was standing in the pipes overnight.

A treatment system was / was not present at time of final sampling.
