

Fire Safety Permit Guide

A Fire Safety Permit must be applied for if you are planning any of the following activities. Please complete an application for a Fire Safety Permit and obtain the permit prior to commencing the activity. Failure to do so will result in enforcement action. Type 1 Permit:

Bonfire, campfire, torch/flame producing device, open flame/device with public gathering, tent/canopy, air supported structure, welding/cutting, explosives, blasting agent, use of multi-purpose room, temporary use of building, storage/handling of Class 1 flammable liquids, storage/handling of Class II or IIIA combustible liquids, permanent cooking suppression system

Type 2 Permit:

Fumigation, thermal insecticide fogging, Carnivals/Circuses, LPG/propane use in excess of 5lb cylinders and storage for cylinder exchange program.

Type 3 Permit:

Ovens/furnaces, wrecking yards, junk yards, outdoor tire storage, discharge of fireworks

Type 4 Permit:

Store or handle more than 55 gallons of corrosive liquids, 500 lbs of oxidizing materials, 10 lbs of organic peroxides, 500 lbs of nitro methane, 1,000 lbs of ammonium nitrate, one micro curie of radium, any amount of radioactive material, 10 lbs of flammable solids, 10 lbs of magnesium, storage, handling of flammable, combustible and unstable liquids more than 660 gallons
