DOYOU NEED HELP PAYING YOUR ENERGY BILLS?

Morris County Organization for Hispanic Affairs can assist you and your family stay warm this winter. MCOHA currently has various energy assistance programs for low-income as well as moderate-income clients.

Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program is a federally funded program that helps low-income households pay for heating costs (this would include electric, natural gas, oil and other deliverable fuels). You may qualify even if your heat is included in your rent! This program runs from October 1st to April 30th and it is based on income and household size.

Cooling Assistance is a program that gives up to an additional \$200 to people that medically require air conditioning during the summer. Must follow same LIHEAP procedures and guidelines.

Gift of Warmth provides additional assistance to those who are New Jersey Natural Gas clients.

Universal Service Fund is a state program that helps pay for electric and natural gas costs to those who fall within the income guidelines and spend more than three percent of household income on gas and/or electricity, or six percent of household income on electric heating.

TRUE Program helps moderate income households pay their natural gas and electric bills. Households must meet certain requirements, such as not be eligible for USF or LIHEAP and have 4- \$25 payments made within 6 months.

NJ SHARES allows those households that don't qualify for LIHEAP, USF or TRUE, that have made a good faith payment and that are going through a financial crisis to obtain a credit on their energy bills.




WHY CHOOSE MCOHA?
