#### CORRESPONDENCE

Verizon has again requested response on cell poles.

**Robert** reviewed the Tempe Wick District and reported he was unable to find the proposed locations since the units are to be set on new Verizon poles and house numbers were not definitive.

**Pat** reviewed Pleasant Valley and Union Schoolhouse Roads and was also frustrated because of the lack of specificity regarding location and the fact that there are no poles on Union School House Road which she observed was a very historic natural site. New poles and equipment would be an encroachment.

Pat and Bob both questioned how power would be provided to the poles.

**Ray** responded to Verizon, informing that we are reviewing the proposed sites and will respond with our comments.

The Committee concluded that in order to continue an evaluation, the locations would need to be staked by Verizon and they would need to address the issue of providing power. **Ray** will respond to Verizon. He will indicate encroachment of the Historic Natural area.

Christine notified the Committee of her immediate resignation. We are all regretful of her need to resign. We will miss her.

The Township has set a budget of \$500 for Historic Preservation. **Ray** will respond.

Ray and Bierce are responding to requests for assistance in designing an interpretive sign for the new Union School House Bridge.

Pat indicated that the Melanie will replace the photo of the restored "First welded bridge" on Roxiticus Road on the HPC portion of the Township Web Site and will work with Ray on future changes.
