Fines will be issued for repeated False Alarms: Second False Alarm \$75.00, Third \$100.00, Fourth \$200.00, and an additional \$100 for each subsequent false alarm. Fines will be an additional \$100.00 for each incident if there is no current registration on file.

Any person having a premises protected by an alarm device shall still be responsible for the registration thereof in accordance with Ch. 82-4. It shall be further condition precedent to the issuance of an Alarm Registration that each permittee, alarm contractor and licensee agree, in writing, to indemnify and save harmless the Township of Mendham, its agents, volunteers, servants and employees, including the members of the Police Department of the Township, from and on account of any and all damages arising from or as a result of any forced entry into unattended premises occurring during an alarm response. Ch. 82-10
