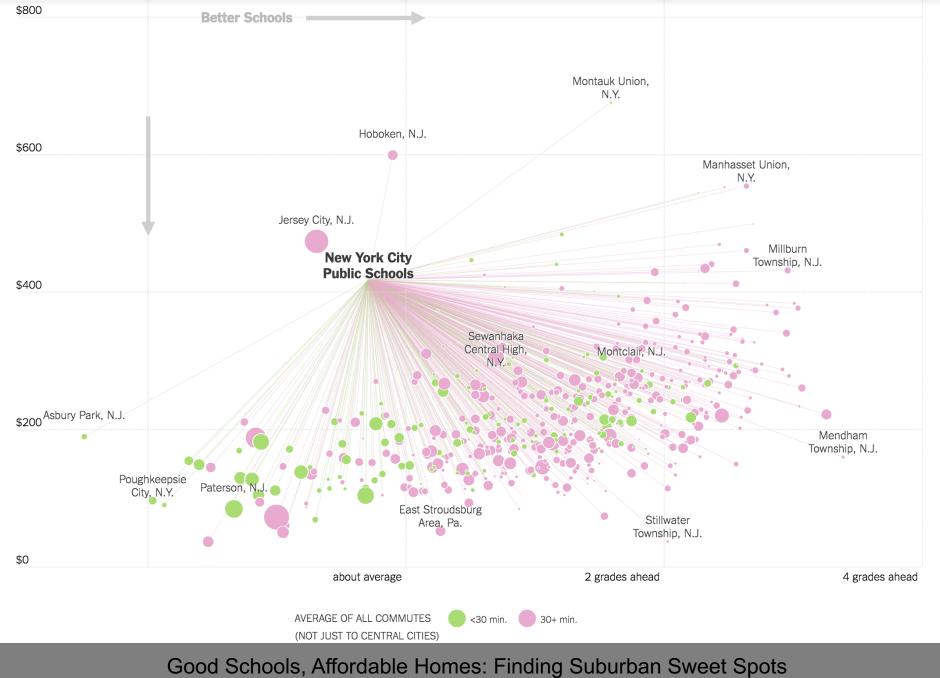

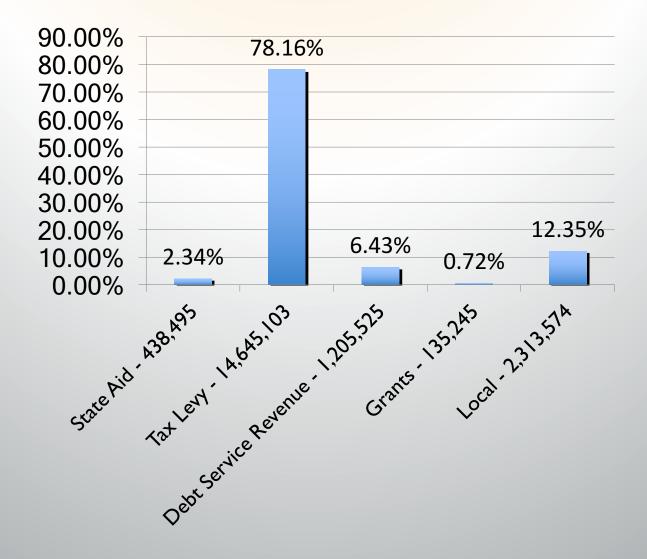
# Budget-Development Process Zero-Based Approach

#### Site-based review (school and department) + District-level review + Board of Education review + Public input = Informed, student-centered decision making

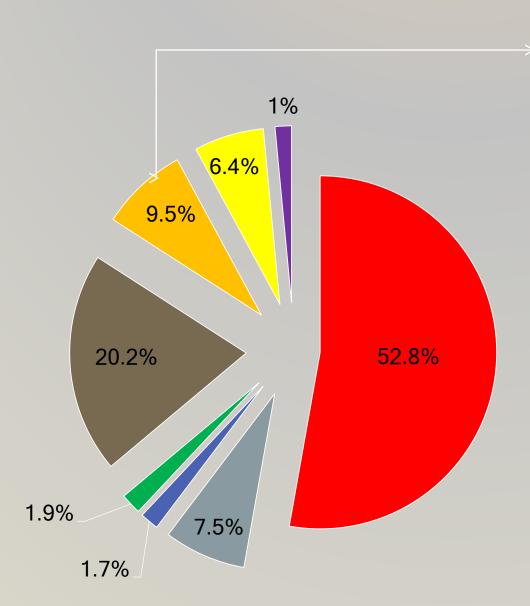

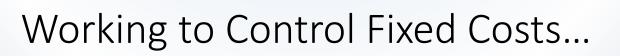

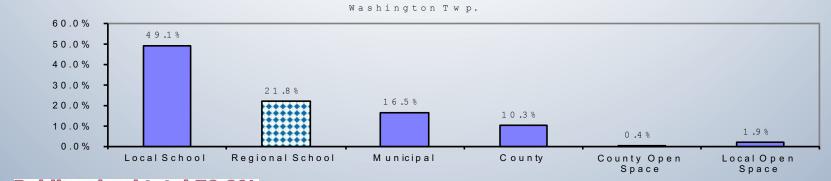
Tax Impact Is For 2017-2018

2017 Mendham Township Total Ratables: \$1,874,558,760 +\$1,240,960

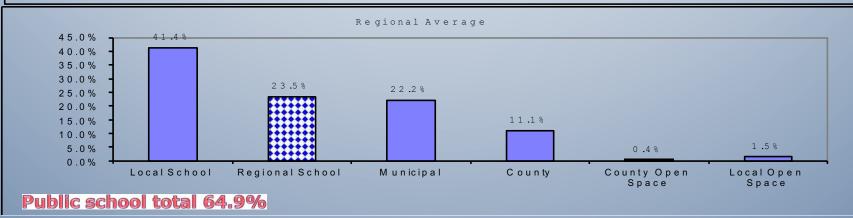




#### Public school total 66.8%
