

Beginning February 17<sup>th</sup> 2023, the Mendham Township Police Department began equipping our officers with body worn cameras (BWC's). These cameras will be used, as per the NJ Attorney General's Guidelines, to capture video and audio recordings of police/citizen interactions. All uniformed officers who are required to be equipped with body worn cameras will wear them on the front of their uniform around mid-chest. The use of body worn cameras is a valuable tool to assist our officers in the successful prosecution of criminal cases. In addition, the recordings will also serve to strengthen the trust and transparency of our department with the public.
