WHEREAS, the municipal tax assessor and tax appeal counsel have negotiated settlements of a real property tax appeals pending in the Tax Court of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the settlements are conditioned upon approval by the governing body of the Township of Mendham.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Mendham, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that the following proposed settlements are approved:

- 1. Block 111, Lot 28 2020 assessment to be reduced to \$1,695,636, resulting in an anticipated refund in the amount of \$5,927.71.
- 2. Block 119, Lot 3 2021 assessment to be reduced to \$1,100,000, resulting in an anticipated refund in the amount of 4,864.17.
- 3. Block 108, Lot 21 2020 assessment to be reduced to \$1,300,000 and 2021 assessment to be reduced to \$1,200,000, resulting in an anticipated refund in the amount of \$9,157.49.

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MENDHAM AMENDING THE CONTRACT FOR CORNERSTONE ARCHITECTURAL GROUP, LLC FOR REDESIGN OF THE ELECTRICAL SERVICE OF THE TOWN HALL RENOVATIONS/ NEW POLICE BUILDING FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the Township of Mendham has authorized a contract with Cornerstone Architectural Group for the construction of the new Mendham Township Police Station at 4 West Main Street, Brookside; and

WHEREAS, a review of the planned transformer and electrical service requires a relocation; and

WHEREAS, Cornerstone Architectural Group and Jersey Central Power & Light (JCP&L) engineers have determined that it will be better to utilize the existing ground-mounted transformer to provide power for the police and townhall facilities; and

WHEREAS, the cost of a redesign of the electrical needs is estimated to be a fee of \$6,500; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified as to the availability of funds pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.4, said funds to be encumbered from account C-04-55-021-001.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Mendham, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that the contract with Cornerstone Architectural Group be amended for an additional \$6,500.

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MENDHAM AMENDING THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT TO CORNERSTONE ARCHITECTURAL GROUP FOR ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN AND BASE CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW POLICE FACILITY AT 4 WEST MAIN STREET TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL SERVICES: CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT

WHEREAS, the Township of Mendham has appointed via Resolution 2020-083 Cornerstone Architectural Group, LLC for the construction of a new Police Facility at 4 West Main Street in an amount not to exceed \$200,000; and

WHEREAS, this existing contract was increased by \$6,500 by Resolution 2021–204 to provide for additional electrical services; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend this contract to reflect additional services to be provided by Cornerstone Architectural Group, LLC for Construction Management Services; and

WHEREAS, the existing contract provides for monthly inspection of the construction program with a formal site meeting and reports to the Township Committee. The Township staff recommends that this be supplemented to provide additional weekly on-site inspections of the construction activity in conjunction with the site inspections performed by Township staff to ensure that the building construction is proceeding according to approved plans and in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified as to the availability of funds pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.4, said funds to be encumbered from Capital Ordinance 14-2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Committee of the Township of Mendham, County of Morris, State of New Jersey does hereby authorize the Mayor to execute and the Township Clerk to witness an amendment to the existing contract with Cornerstone Architectural Group, LLC, to increase the amount not to exceed \$20,000 for a revised contract amount of \$226,500.

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MENDHAM RECOGNIZING THE EXTRA DUTY BY THE TOWNSHIP PUBLIC WORKS SUPERINTENDENT

WHEREAS, the Mendham Township Public Works Superintendent is a managerial employee of the Township and as such, it not eligible for any "overtime pay" as required under State and Federal regulations; and

WHEREAS, David Read, the Township Public Works Superintendent, is available and does respond at all times to emergency conditions in the Township as well as other requests for assistance outside the normal work hours of the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, during the 2020 – 2021 snow season, the Township employed outside contractors to plow snow on three separate storms resulting in a total of 60 hours of contract operations for each provided piece of equipment; and

WHEREAS, David Read was present and actively working during these three emergency events without compensation, and the Township Committee believes that there should be some form of compensation when the emergency conditions in the municipality requires Mr. Read's presence on an extended basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Mendham, County of Morris, State of New Jersey that the Township Administrator is authorized to compensate David Read for 60 hours of additional pay to recognize the time requirement for emergency response during these three snow events.

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Mendham is subject to certain requirements of the <u>Open Public Meetings Act</u>, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6, <u>et seq.</u>; and

WHEREAS, the <u>Open Public Meetings Act</u>, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12, provides that an Executive Session, not open to the public, may be held for certain specified purposes when authorized by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Township Committee of the Township of Mendham to discuss in a session not open to the public certain matters relating to the item or items authorized by N.J.S.A. 10:4-12b and designated below: (1) Matters Required by Law to be Confidential: Any matter which, by express provision of Federal law or State statute or rule of court shall be rendered confidential or excluded from the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act. (2) Matters Where the Release of Information Would Impair the Right to Receive Funds: Any matter in which the release of information would impair a right to receive funds from the Government of the United States. (3) Matters Involving Individual Privacy: Any material the disclosure of which constitutes an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy such as any records, data, reports, recommendations, or other personal material of any educational, training, social service, medical, health, custodial, child protection, rehabilitation, legal defense, welfare, housing, relocation, insurance and similar program or institution operated by a public body pertaining to any specific individual admitted to or served by such institution or program, including but not limited to information relative to the individual's personal and family circumstances, and any material pertaining to admission, discharge, treatment, progress or condition of any individual, unless the individual concerned (or, in the case of a minor or incompetent, his guardian) shall request in writing that the same be disclosed publicly. (4) Matters Relating to Collective Bargaining Agreements: Any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body. (5) Matters Relating to the Purchase, Lease or Acquisition of Real Property or the Investment of Public Funds: Any matter involving the purchase, lease or acquisition of real property with public funds, the setting of banking rates or investment of public funds, where it could adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed. (6) Matters Relating to Public Safety and Property: Any tactics and techniques utilized in protecting the safety and property of the public provided that their disclosure could impair such protection. Any investigations of violations of possible violations of the law. (7) Matters Relating to Litigation, Negotiations and the Attorney-Client Privilege: Any pending or

anticipated litigation or contract negotiation in which the public body is, or may become a party. Any
