WHEREAS, the Township entered into three-year employment agreements with management personnel in the Police Department in May of 2017 setting for terms and conditions of employment; and

WHEREAS, the Police Management personnel involved have requested that these employment agreements be extended for an additional three-year period without any change; and

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MENDHAM TO APPROVE A SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF RANDOLPH FOR ANIMAL SHELTER SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Township of Mendham has a contract with Animal Control Services of Flemington, New Jersey for Animal Control Services plus animal shelter services; and

WHEREAS, the availability of a local animal shelter would be a convenience to Mendham Township residents who need to reclaim an animal who has been picked up by the Animal Control Officer; and

WHEREAS, under the contract with Animal Control Services the location of the Animal Shelter is a local option; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Randolph has agreed to provide animal shelter services through a Shared Service Agreement with the Township of Mendham; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to set forth the terms and conditions and procedures for the sharing of Animal Shelter Services among the municipalities which are a party to this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Services Act (N. J. S. A. 40:65-1 et seq.) provides the mechanism for local governments to enter into contracts for the joint provision of required services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MENDHAM, COUNTY OF MORRIS, NJ AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Shared Service Animal Shelter Agreement attached to and made a part of this Resolution is hereby approved, the Mayor is Authorized to execute the same on behalf of the Township, and the Township Administrator is authorized to take the necessary actions to implement the Agreement.
- 2. A certified copy of this resolution and the Animal Shelter Contract is to be provided to the Township of Randolph for their approval.
- 3. A copy of the Shared Service agreement shall be filed with the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs.

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MENDHAM AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A NON-FAIR AND OPEN PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING TO CORNERSTONE ARCHITECTURAL GROUP FOR ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN AND BASE CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR RENOVATIONS TO THE TOWN HALL

WHEREAS, the Township of Mendham has a need to appoint a licensed professional architect through a non-fair and open contract pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 or 20.5 as appropriate; and

WHEREAS, Cornerstone Architectural Group did the feasibility analysis for renovations to the Town Hall Building; and

WHEREAS, Cornerstone Architectural Group will provide licensed professional architectural services as sought by the Township of Mendham as outlined in a proposal dated November 17, 2020 in an amount not to exceed \$209,000; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et. seq.) requires that the Resolution authorizing the award of contracts for Professional Services without competitive bids and the contract itself must be available for public inspection; and

WHEREAS, Cornerstone Architectural Group will provide and submit a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that the firm has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the Township of Mendham with the elected officials in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit him from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified as to the availability of funds pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 5:30-5.4, said funds to be encumbered from Bond Ordinance 2020- 12.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Mendham, County of Morris, State of New Jersey authorizes the Mayor and the Township Clerk to enter into a contract with Cornerstone Architectural Group not to exceed \$209,000 for architectural servicers as outlined in the Professional Services Contract attached to and made a part of this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor is authorized to sign this contract on behalf of the Township once the Township Attorney has approved of the document as to form and legality.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contract, resolution and all other pertinent documents shall remain on file in the office of the Township Clerk.
