### RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MENDHAM PROVIDING FOR A MEETING NOT OPEN TO THE PUBLIC IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE NEW JERSEY OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12

**WHEREAS,** the Township Committee of the Township of Mendham is subject to certain requirements of the <u>Open Public Meetings Act</u>, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6, <u>et seq.</u>; and

**WHEREAS,** the <u>Open Public Meetings Act</u>, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12, provides that an Executive Session, not open to the public, may be held for certain specified purposes when authorized by Resolution; and

**WHEREAS,** it is necessary for the Township Committee of the Township of Mendham to discuss in a session not open to the public certain matters relating to the item or items authorized by N.J.S.A. 10:4-12b and designated below:

(1) Matters Required by Law to be Confidential: Any matter which, by express provision of Federal law or State statute or rule of court shall be rendered confidential or excluded from the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act.
(2) Matters Where the Release of Information Would Impair the Right to Receive Funds: Any matter in which the release of information would impair a right to receive funds from the Government of the United States.
(3) Matters Involving Individual Privacy: Any material the disclosure of which constitutes an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy such as any records, data, reports, recommendations, or other personal material of any educational, training, social service, medical, health, custodial, child protection, rehabilitation, legal defense, welfare, housing, relocation, insurance and similar program or institution operated by a public body pertaining to any specific individual admitted to or served by such institution or program, including but not limited to information relative to the individual's personal and family circumstances, and any material pertaining to admission, discharge, treatment, progress or condition of any individual, unless the individual concerned (or, in the case of a minor or incompetent, his guardian) shall request in writing that the same be disclosed publicly.
(4) Matters Relating to Collective Bargaining Agreements: Any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body.
(5) Matters Relating to the Purchase, Lease or Acquisition of Real Property or the Investment of Public Funds: Any matter involving the purchase, lease or acquisition of real property with public funds, the setting of banking rates or investment of public funds, where it could adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed.
(6) Matters Relating to Public Safety and Property: Any tactics and techniques utilized in protecting the safety and property of the public provided that their disclosure could impair such protection. Any investigations of violations of possible violations of the law.
(7) Matters Relating to Litigation, Negotiations, and the Attorney-Client Privilege: Any pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation in which the public body is or may become a party. Any matters falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is required in order for the attorney to exercise his ethical duties as a lawyer.

(8) Matters Relating to the Employment Relationship: Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the performance of promotion or disciplining of any specific prospective public officer or employee or current public officer or employee employed or appointed by the public body, unless all the individual employees or appointees whose right could be adversely affected request in writing that such matter or matters be discussed at a public meeting.
(9) Matters Relating to the Potential Imposition of a Penalty: Any deliberations of a public body occurring after a public hearing that may result in the imposition of a specific civil penalty upon the responding party or the suspension or loss of a license or permit belonging to the responding party bears responsibility.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Mendham, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey, assembled in public session on **March 11, 2024 at 6:30 P.M.** in the Mendham Township Middle School, 16 Washington Valley Road, Brookside, New Jersey, that the Township Committee shall meet in Executive Session, from which the public shall be excluded, for the discussion of matters relating to the specific items designated above.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that it is anticipated that the deliberations conducted in closed session may be disclosed to the public upon the determination of the Township Committee that the public interest will no longer be served by such confidentiality.

### ORDINANCE 02-2024 TOWNSHIP OF MENDHAM COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

#### **CALENDAR YEAR 2024**

### ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A:4 45.14)

**WHEREAS**, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A:4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget to 2.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Township of Mendham, in the County of Morris, finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2024 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee hereby determines that a 3.5% increase in the budget for said year, is estimated to be \$275,476.31 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated, as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Governing Body of the Township of Mendham, in the County of Morris, a majority of the full authorized of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2024 budget year, the final appropriations of the Township of Mendham shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40: 45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$272,476.31 and that the CY 2024 municipal budget for the Township of Mendham be approved and adopt accordance with ordinance; and,

**BE IF FURTHER ORDAINED**, that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, with the that a director certified copy of this ordinance as of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

**BE IF FURTHER ORDAINED** that a certified copy adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon be within 5 days after such adoption of this ordinance upon field with said Director.

### RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MENDHAM AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT FOR STEPHEN SHEA BUILDING SUB-CODE INSPECTOR

WHEREAS, Stephen Shea was appointed by the Township as Building Subcode Inspector in 2018; and

WHEREAS, As part of the regular duties of a subcode inspector requires driving to and from various inspections; and

WHEREAS, the Plumbing, Electrical, and Fire Inspectors all receive a mileage stipend; and

**WHEREAS**, The Township Administrator and Construction Official recommend paying mileage reimbursement to Stephen Shea at a rate equivalent to the official IRS rate (currently 67 cents per mile); and

WHEREAS, Stephen Shea will be required to submit a weekly mileage log; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Mendham, County of Morris, authorize the mileage reimbursement to Stephen Shea for his Mendham Township building subcode inspections based on the annual IRS Rate (67 cents per mile for 2024)

# RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MENDHAM AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A NON-FAIR AND OPEN PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING TO FRENCH AND PARRELLO ASSOCIATES FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE VALUATION OF THE MENDHAM EAST AND WEST SEWER UTILITIES

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Mendham is in need of an engineer to review and value the Mendham East and West Sewer Plants for the purpose of possibly selling the sewer systems; and

WHEREAS French and Parrello and Eric C. Betz, P.E., Vice President and Senior Project Consultant and Director of Water and Wastewater, , will provide engineering services for the valuation of the Mendham East and West Sewer Systems at an amount not to exceed \$29,500; as outlined in the proposal dated September 27, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et. seq.) requires that the Resolution authorizing the award of contracts for Professional Services without competitive bids and the contract itself must be available for public inspection; and

**WHEREAS**, the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 or 20.5 concerning appointment through a non-fair and open contract require a resolution of the governing body when the total value of all such contracts in a year to a single firm exceed \$17,500; and

**WHEREAS**, French and Parrello will provide and submit a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that the firm has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the Township of Mendham with the elected officials in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit him from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Township Chief Financial Officer will provide the funding for this contract in the 2024 Temporary and final budget for the Sewer East and Sewer West Utilities.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Mendham, County of Morris, State of New Jersey authorizes the Mayor and the Township Clerk to enter into a contract with French and Parrello Associates not to exceed \$29,500 for a sewer system valuation.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the contract, resolution, and all other pertinent documents shall remain on file in the office of the Township Clerk; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a notice of this action shall be printed once in the Township's legal newspaper.

# RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MENDHAM AMENDING THE CONTRACT FOR S. HOURAN USA CONTRACTORS, LLC FOR CHANGES TO THE TOWN HALL IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDING MOLD REMEDIATION, HVAC RE-DESIGN AND ASBESTOS

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Mendham has authorized a contract with S. Houran USA Contracting, LLC for the construction and improvements to Town Hall at 2 West Main Street; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that mold has been found on the first floor in the Children's Library area and needs to be remediated at a cost of \$16,800; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined a modification to the Main Supply and Return Ductwork for the new roof top HVAC Unit and Curb Extender is necessary due to a change in design by the manufacturer at an estimated cost of \$10,358.61; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined a modification to asbestos was found in roofing materials during removal of the existing roof membrane, parapet reconstruction and was unforeseen at the time the roof repairs at a cost of \$10,954.65; and

WHEREAS, these changes were unforeseen by the contractor and reviewed and approved by the architect; and

**WHEREAS,** the Chief Financial Officer has certified as to the availability of funds pursuant to N.J.A.C 5:30-5.4

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Mendham, County of Morris, State of New Jersey that the contract with S. Houran USA be amended for an additional \$38,113.26.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the contract, resolution and all other pertinent documents shall remain on file in the office of the Township Clerk.
