Hunter Information Sheet

All hunters wishing to hunt in the Township of Mendham shall follow the steps listed below:

- 1. All hunters must have a valid hunting license issued by the state of New Jersey for the current season.
 - 2. All hunters must have completed the New Jersey state hunter safety class or equivalent.

Anyone submitting a Mendham Township hunting permit application for the first time is required to review the documents on the Mendham Township Police website at <u>www.mendhamtownship.org</u>. Once you review these documents, you must email Toni
Gallicchio and confirm you have viewed and understand the local ordinance and park scheduling rules. Your permit will then be able to be released. <u>tgallicchio@mendhamtownship.org</u>

4. All hunters must complete the application and answer all questions. Applications must be legible. Any application that is not complete or accurate will be rejected.

5. Return completed application with a check or money order for \$20.00 made payable to the Township of Mendham. Applications received after September 30, 2023 will require a \$40.00 fee. Mail fully completed form to Mendham Township Police Department, PO Box 236 Brookside, NJ, 07926.

6. All issued permits may be picked up in person any time after September 1, 2023. Call ahead for pick-up hours as the office hours may change. <u>PLEASE NOTE our new address is 4 W. Main St, right next</u> to the Brookside Fore Department.

Applicants may be checked for prior fish and wildlife violations and other hunting related offenses. A prior violation does not automatically result in the denial of a permit, however the Chief of Police reserves the right to deny any applicant which may pose a risk to the safety of the residents of Mendham Township
